

'Flying Saucer' Was Good Description of Meteor

SYDNEY, Friday. — The Government Astronomer (Mr. Harley Wood) said today that a "flying saucer", which more than a dozen people said they saw on Wednesday, was a meteor.

"Two of the descriptions we had of the 'saucer' were the best we ever had of a meteor", he said.

The "flying saucer" was seen about 7 p.m. on Wednesday by people in Brisbane, Glen Innes, Gladstone, Murwillumbah, Lismore, Kyogle, Mallanganee, Kempsey, and Homebush.

"The meteor would be about 80 miles up, and traveling faster than 25 miles a second", Mr. Wood said. "That is the reason why it was seen over such a wide area".
