

Flying Saucer Was A Meteor

Sydney, December 6.—The Government Astronomer (Harley Wood) said that a flying saucer, which more than a dozen people said they saw on Wednesday, was a meteor.

"Two of the descriptions we had of the saucer were the best we have ever had of a meteor," he said.

The "flying saucer" was seen about 7 p.m. on Wednesday by people in Brisbane, Glen Innes, Gladstone and Homebush.

"The meteor would be about 87 miles up and travelling faster than 25 miles a second. That is the reason why it was seen over such a wide area," Mr. Wood said.
