

## Flying Saucer Over the City

**M**ARYBOROUGH residents last night watched a "flying saucer" speeding round the sky. The object was first seen at Granville by the president of the Maryborough Sub-branch of the R.S.L., Mr. S. Bryant-Smith, and his wife. The "saucer" was first seen at a great height by Mrs. Bryant-Smith. It came down to about 2000 feet and then began to move northwards in a great circular sweep at an estimated 400 to 500 miles an hour. As it returned towards the city it went down to a low level and when about over the River Heads it began a great upward movement. In this movement it travelled almost perpendicularly. It then stayed over the city in a small circular movement at a low altitude and then disappeared at a great height and speed. In its course the "saucer" emitted different coloured lights, but mostly showed a bright blue light.
