

"FLYING SAUCER" REPORT

SYDNEY MAN'S STORY.

SYDNEY, Dec. 13.—Mr. Fred Soult (59), of Concord, thinks he saw a "flying saucer" to-night.

Mr Soult said that he saw "a brilliant disc-like object" flash across the sky and disappear in a northerly direction.

"It was bright blue and had no tail," said Mr. Soult. "I have seen plenty of falling stars and meteors, but this was something I had never seen before. I watched it for three or four seconds before it disappeared. It looked like a 'flying saucer,' because it had a disc-like shape."

Neither the civil aviation control authorities at Mascot, nor the Sydney Weather Bureau, nor the Riverview College Observatory had any inquiries about "flying saucers" or meteors to-night.
