

## THINKS HE SAW FLYING SAUCER

SYDNEY, Dec. 13. Mr. Fred Scull (59), of Concord, thinks that he saw a "flying saucer" to-night. Mr. Scull said he saw "a brilliant disc-like object" flash across the sky and disappear in a northern direction. It was "bright blue and had no tail," said Mr. Scull, who added: "I have seen plenty of falling stars and meteors, but this was something I had never seen before. I watched it for three or four seconds before it disappeared. It looked like a flying saucer because it had a disc-like shape. Neither the Civil Aviation Control authorities at Mascot, the Sydney Weather Bureau, nor the River-view College Observatory had any reports about "flying saucers" or meteors to-night."
