

THINKS HE SAW FLYING SAUCER

SYDNEY, December 13.—Mr. Fred Soult, 59, of Concord, thinks he saw a "flying saucer" to-night.

Mr. Soult said he saw "a brilliant disc-like object flash across the sky and disappear in a northerly direction.

"It was bright blue, and had no tail," said Mr. Soult, who added: "I have seen plenty of falling stars and meteors, but this was something I had never seen before. I watched it for three or four seconds before it disappeared.

"I looked like a flying saucer because it had a disc-like shape," he said.

Neither the Civil Aviation control authorities at Mascot, the Sydney Weather Bureau, nor the Riverview College Observatory had any inquiries about "flying saucers" or meteors to-night.
