

EVERYONE ON AIRLINER SAW "FLYING SAUCER"

LONDON, Monday. — All nine passengers and the crew of two of an airliner on a regular East African Airways flight signed a statement after landing at Nairobi today that they saw a "flying saucer" like an airship hovering for 14 minutes over Africa's highest peak, Kilimanjaro.

They described it as "metallic, silvery, bullet-shaped, apparently with tail fins."

Two American passengers photographed it with telescopic cameras.

A British passenger, Capt. H. H. Fussell, who watched it with powerful binoculars, said: "It looked like a sausage with vertical marks. After hovering about 30,000ft. it rose to 40,000 ft., stayed still for a minute and then flew off eastward at a terrific rate."
