

# Scientist Attacks U.S. Navy Over Flying Saucer Claims

**NEW YORK, Monday.** — A former Air Force scientist has ripped into Navy Technician Dr. Liddel for claiming that the flying saucers were nothing more than Naval research balloons.

Dr. Anthony Mirarchi says: "The Navy report is erroneous and lulls people into a false sense of security. If flying saucers are experimental missiles they could lead to worse than Pearl Harbour."

Dr. Mirarchi said he carefully studied files covering

hundreds of eye-witness reports on the flying saucers, and considers there is strong evidence that objects seen were "manoeuvred motion." He adds the motion described did not indicate any natural phenomenon or drifting balloons.

Air Force spokesmen declare that despite the Navy's statements the Air Force has not terminated its long study of the flying saucer rumors, but is continuing it under the direction of Colonel Harold Watson.
