

FLYING SAUCER AGAIN

MITCHELL FIELD, New York, Sept. 11.—Two Air Force jet fighter pilots reported to-day they had chased a mysterious round flying object for 30 miles yesterday without being able to catch it.

They estimated it was travelling about 900 miles an hour.

The pilots, Lieut. Wilbert Rogers and Captain Edward Ballard, were flying in a jet training aircraft when they sighted the object over Sandy Hook, New Jersey.

"I don't know if it was a flying saucer, but it sure was something I've never seen before," Lieut. Rogers said.

Lieut. Rogers described the object as white or silver

colored and about the size of a fighter plane.

Lieut. Rogers said he lost sight of the object when it turned out to sea.

The Air Force and Navy have announced that "flying saucers" previously reported have been weather balloons.

"This could not have been a balloon," Lieut. Rogers said, "because it was descending and no balloon goes that fast."
