

# **FLYING SAUCER AGAIN**

**NEW YORK, Tues.—**

**Two Air Force jet fighter pilots reported today that they had chased a mysterious round flying object for 30 miles yesterday without being able to catch it.**

**They estimated that it was travelling about 900 m.p.h.**

**The pilots were flying in a jet training aircraft when they sighted the object over Sandy Hook, New Jersey.**

**"I don't know if it was a flying saucer, but it sure was**

ying saucer, but it sure was something I've never seen before," said Lt. Rogers, one of the pilots. We couldn't have caught it in an F-86."

[The F-86 Sabre is America's fastest jet fighter.]

Lt. Rogers described the object as white or silver-coloured and about the size of a fighter plane.

"We were travelling at 450 a.p.h., but we soon found we could not catch it."

The Air Force and Navy have announced that "flying saucers" previously reported have been weather balloons.

"This could not have been a balloon," said Lt. Rogers, "because it was descending, and no balloon goes that fast."
