

HIS OWN FLYING SAUCER

Residents along the Canada - United States border, near Hogansburg, reported seeing a "fantastic flying ball" whizzing through the skies yesterday.

Today a Canadian rang the Canadian Press Office in Toronto and claimed that he helped build the contraption.

He gave his name as Arthur Greenwood.

Greenwood said the object was a plastic, egg-shaped balloon, measuring six feet across, and powered by an electric motor that drove a propeller.

He said the balloon could reach a speed of 210 miles an hour.

It took off from a secret hiding place near Ancaster yesterday, he said, and returned to another hiding place near Toronto.

Its next flight would be over Niagara Falls on Sunday.—A.A.P.
