

AIR FORCE TO SEEK SAUCER SOURCES

Washington, Friday.—The U.S. Air Force has alerted the field commands to report any unconventional aerial objects which cannot be explained by the usual weather balloons and natural phenomena in evaluation of flying saucer reports.

An air force spokesman issued the following statement in response to inquiries about a revival of reports of unidentified flying objects, popularly known as flying saucers:

“Every attempt is being made to investigate sightings reported to the air force.

In most cases, the sightings have proved to be weather balloons and natural phenomena.

“There remain, however, a number of reported sightings, that cannot be thus explained, and as long as this is true the air force will continue to study the problem.

“The U.S. Air Force field commands have been alerted to report unconventional

ed to report unconventional aerial objects in an effort to obtain additional information.

“The Public should not interpret these continued efforts to mean that new evaluations or new conclusions have been reached. This is not the case.

“Detailed reports, and particularly photographs, from people who have sighted aerial manifestations will be welcomed.”
