

Canadian query on "saucers"

OTTAWA, Thurs. —
Canadian scientists
and Air Force officers

investigation.

was on January 1 last, and

Intelligence officers have

The chairman of the Canadian Defence Research Board (Dr. O. M. Solandt) said last night: "We are as mystified as anyone else, and we are keeping an open mind."

Dr. Peter Millman, prominent astro - physicist, said: "We can't laugh off these observations."

The chairman of the Atomic Energy Control Board (Dr. C. J. Mackenzie) said: "These reports cannot be disregarded as nonsense."

A spokesman for the R.C.A.F. said the men who reported having seen the flying objects were reliable and stable.
