

Fighters Chase 1,000 m.p.h. Mystery 'Plane'

NEW YORK, April 21 (A.A.P.).—Reports of an unidentified aircraft, flying at an estimated speed of 1,000 miles an hour, and leaving a vapour trail at 30,000ft, were received yesterday from widely separated points in western Ontario.

Fighter planes from the City of London R.C.A.F. Reserve Squadron were directed to intercept the mysterious aircraft, but the Mustang pilots reported they could not get near the plane.
