

## *Weather Note: COASTAL SAUCERS*

**TWEED HEADS, Sat. — Two New South Wales policemen to-night saw a "Flying Saucer."**

They said it flashed across Tweed Heads at "unearthly speed."

Both policemen, Constables A. D. Rizzi and G. H. Urwin, of the N.S.W. police force, were going on duty at 8.40 p.m. A circle of lights swept in from the sea at about 20,000ft.

Constable Rizzi said the lights were visible for about 20 seconds before they vanished. He added that thousands of

small white lights were crowded together in the circle.

Constable Rizzi told friends: "It was the strangest sight that anybody could ever see. The circle, which seemed to be of giant dimensions, moved at indescribable speed.

"It swept inland in a south-westerly direction and vanished in the darkness."

[This makes the second report of "flying saucers" near Brisbane this week. On Wednesday night Mrs. L. Wilson, of Broadwater, 16 miles from Dalby, said she and her family had sighted three "saucers" on Good Friday (April 11).]
