

NZ farmer sees a "blue saucer" —

WELLINGTON, Mon. — A "flying saucer" was reported today by a North Auckland farmer, J. Erceg, at Kokopu, 13 miles west of Whangarei.

The farmer claims to have seen an oval boat-shaped object travelling across the sky at 10.35 p.m. on Saturday.

Erceg said that the object, which was a bright blue, seemed about 10 to 12 feet long. It travelled across the night sky, north to south, "slower than a meteor, but faster than a plane".

Erceg claims to have seen it while he was returning with his family from an evening at the pictures.

But over Adelaide it was "orange-red"

ADELAIDE, Mon. — Mr V. W. Lehmann, of Brighton, claims there was a flying saucer over Adelaide early today.

"I'm sure I wasn't seeing things," he said. "It appeared in the eastern sky, over the Adelaide hills, about 1.52 a.m.

"It was flying north at a terrific speed. I saw it eight times.

"It looked like an Army tin plate and was orange-red in color."
