

Flying Saucer Stir

Melbourne—Commonwealth Defence and Security officers will investigate reports of flying saucers over South Australia, Victoria, and New South Wales.

They are making a file of newspaper reports of eye-witnesses' accounts and when it is complete, they may interview some of the eye-witnesses for more information.

The question arose whether the objects sighted could be a civil aviation hazard.

Two major questions, if promptly answered, could

provide valuable evidence.

They are : —

In what direction was the object flying when seen?

Did it have light, like porthole lights, from end to end, or was it aglow all over?

If the object was on a varying course, and if it had "porthole" lights, it would hardly be a meteorological phenomenon.
