

# SAUCER—OR METEOR?

SYDNEY, Monday. —

Scientists believe a "flying saucer" reported over New South Wales and Victoria on Saturday was a meteor.

But Commonwealth security officers will investigate reports by more than a dozen people that a silent cigar-shaped object was visible at about 6.10 a.m. on Saturday.

Two Victorian scientists, Mr. P. Gartner and Mr. W. J. Fletcher, saw the object and believe it was a large meteor.

Astronomers, aeronautical scientists, and other skilled observers in New South Wales support this view.
