

## Fishermen See Flying Saucer

BUNDABERG, May 13. —

Three Bundaberg men, employess of the Bundaberg laundry, while fishing on Monday night, sighted a bright object in the sky which they later described as a flying saucer.

The three men were Ron Corrigan, Des Dahl, and Ted Rayner. The three were out fishing on the Burnett River on Monday night not far from the laundry and adjacent to the Bundaberg traffic bridge, when they saw a silvery, near oval shaped object travelling at great speed across the sky.

The men said that the object appeared to be travelling in an eastern direction at a height of 3000 or 4000 feet, or at the same height of an ordinary plane.

The object in size was about the same as an ordinary plane and was like a football in shape. The three men said they saw it for about ten seconds before it completely disappeared.

A feature of the object was a shaded point in the front. The night was clear and the moon was shining brightly.

Ron Corrigan first saw the saucer and told his mates, but they laughed at him. A few minutes later Ted Rayner saw it and alerted the other two. They vouch that they were not suffering from hallucination.
