NEW YORK, Sun.—Four Florida pilots, three of them World War II veterans, reported to the Civil Aeronautics Administration

today that they had sighted a "Flying Saucer" over the Hanford atomic plant, between Ellensburg and Yakima, Washington.

The four men were members of the crew of a C-46 Conner Airlines aircraft.

They reported that they passed the object "suspended in space" over the atomic plant.

One of the men said he tried to take a photograph of the object, but by the time he had collected his camera from another part of the plane the "Saucer" had disappeared.

#### **MOSSADEQ GETS PARLIAMENT VOTE**

**LONDON, Sun.**—The Persian Parliament today voted for Dr. Mossadeq to continue as Prime Minister.

At a secret session Mossadeq got 53 votes

Two other candidates, Ahmed Ghavam Sultaneh and Nasrollah Entezam, got two votes and one vote, respectively.

Less than 24 hours after resigning office, Mossadeq thus faces the certainty that the Shah will ask him to form a new Cabinet.
