

Veteran Pilots Spot "Flying Saucers"

NEW YORK, July 15.—
Two veteran Pan-American Airways pilots yesterday reported that they saw eight big "flying saucers" flying at 1,000 m.p.h. near Norfolk, Virginia, on Monday night.

The pilots, V. B. Nash and W. H. Fortenberry, were on a routine flight in a DC4 airliner.

They said that the "saucers" were about 100 feet in diameter, between 10 and 15 feet wide, and "glowed orange red like hot coals."

Six of them flew in forma-

tion 6,000 feet beneath the DC4 and turned sharply when the plane passed overhead.

Two other discs then joined the formation and all zoomed to 10,000 feet before their light "pulsated off" and they disappeared.

"They were definitely intelligently controlled, but humans could not physically endure the centrifugal force that would be imposed on them when making turns of such violence as those objects

violence as those objects made." Mr. Nash, who has 10,000 flying hours, said.

"They must have been from some extra-terrestrial source."
