

NO SAUCERS YET DETECTED BY RADAR

DAYTON, Friday.

More than 15 per cent. of reports of Flying Saucers received in the past four years, could not be explained, a United States air force spokesman said today.

Jet fighters with radar had been sent up, but none had yet made contact with a "saucer."

This was stated today by Captain E. J. Ruppelt of the Air Technical Intelligence Centre at Wright-Patterson air base.

He added that ground radar had tracked some unexplainable aerial objects believed to have been travelling at speeds of from 1,500 to 2,000 miles an hour.
