

INTRIGUING LIGHT

Observed Last Night

Shortly after 8 o'clock last night a flying saucer was sighted 170 miles north-west of Sydney at Coolah, and at a number of other towns.

Other observers similarly described the travelling light.

The assistant shire clerk of Coolah Shire, Mr. Len Wholohan, said, "It was flying very high and travelling very fast to the north-east.

"As it passed over the town there was a terrific rumbling noise. Buildings shook.

"It was heart-shaped, and was spouting a multi-coloured flame from the back. The flame was blue, green and red. In my opinion it was not a shooting star."

The Government Astronomer in Sydney (Mr. E. W. Woodcock) said the appearance and behaviour of the object were not inconsistent with its
