

"Flying Saucer" In West

SYDNEY, Tuesday.

A heart-shaped "flying saucer" was seen at Duncdoon and Coolah last night.

Merriwa, Cassilis, Quirindi, Rylstone and Upper Manilla also reported having seen the "saucer."

"As it passed over the town there was a terrific rumbling noise," said Mr. L. Wholohan, assistant Shire Clerk of Coolah Shire.

"It was heart-shaped, and was spouting a multi-colored flame from the back. The flame was blue, green and red. I don't think it was a shooting star."

Licensee of the Hotel Coolah (Mr. J. E. Henville) said that the windows of the hotel vibrated as a flash of light went across the sky about 8 p.m.

The police station at Coolah also trembled and a rumbling noise was heard for about 30 seconds.
