

"Flying Saucer" Seen in W.A.

Katanning, July 25. — Reports just received from widely scattered points east of Katanning say that a comparatively slow-moving object passed through the sky in a north-westerly direction about 4.30 p.m. on Monday.

The object was round and dark, followed by a long vapour trail, and took five minutes to cross the visible sky area. Its passage was accompanied by a noise like low thunder. Five members of one family on a farm 17 miles east of Katanning saw and heard it.

Other people about eight miles away also witnessed the object in the sky.

A further report of sighting has been received from Glencoe, some 15 miles further north-west.

All concerned now want to find out all they can about flying saucers.
