

“FLYING SAUCER” SEEN AT DARWIN

Darwin, Sat: Many Darwin residents believe the strange object which flashed across the sky tonight may have been a flying saucer.

Flash lasted 5 seconds and residents who have seen shooting stars or comets before agree the object was much more brilliant.

It was bright green and appeared to change to red and gold as it gained momentum.

Commander of a Qantas Constellation, Capt J. Murray of Sydney, confirmed what residents saw.

He said he was taxi-ing a Constellation towards

the hangar at Darwin airport when he saw the flash.

He said: "It certainly was not a shooting star or a comet. I believe in flying saucers and I think this may have been one."

A constable said he saw a brilliant green light flashing from east to west some distance south of the town at terrific speed.

A radio technician and patrons of Darwin's open air theatre saw the flash.
