

U.S. Airmen To Chase Flying Saucers

WASHINGTON, Tues.- Jet interceptor pilots of the U.S. Air Defence Command were alerted yesterday for instant take offs in pursuit of any "Flying Saucers" sighted anywhere in the country.

The Command acted after F-94 jets unsuccessfully chased "glowing white lights" seen in the Washington area last Saturday night. Mysterious objects had also been spotted the previous Saturday.

The new batch of saucer reports included unexplained appearances on radar screens, but the Air Force remained sceptical. It said the reports had shown no pattern which would indicate that the objects were being controlled by a reasoning body.

Statements by eyewitnesses, including Air Force and commercial pilots, are being studied and evaluated. Meanwhile interceptor planes are ready to go aloft at any time.

A spokesman of the Air Defence Command

Air Defence Command said the Command's mission was air defence of the U.S. and it was vitally interested in anything unidentified that flies in the air.
