

No Danger From 'Saucers'

WASHINGTON, Wed.—
The United States is
"confident that there is no
danger from 'flying saucers'
or other mystery aerial
objects."

Major General John Samford, Director of the U.S. Air Force Intelligence, said to-day that six years analysis of mysterious objects had revealed no pattern that showed anything remotely consistent with any menace to the U.S.

General Samford headed an Air Force group who held a news conference at the Pentagon, specifically to answer questions from the world's Press arising from recent alarms over unexplained radar and other

unexplained radar and other sightings.

General Samford said less than 20 per cent. of between 1000 and 2000 reported sightings remain unidentified—and this percentage was caused mainly from lack of information by the “saucer” spotters.

“The Air Force will continue to give reports of unidentified flying objects adequate attention, but not frantic attention,” he said.
