

U.S. Air Chief Says They Do Not Exist

NEW YORK, July 31 (A.A.P.).—The U.S. Air Force Chief of Staff, General Hoyt Vandenberg, yesterday said that he does not believe there is any such thing as a flying saucer.

"But apparently there are physical phenomena which make people say they have seen the saucers," he said in Seattle.

"They are not machines flown by men from Mars, nor from any foreign Powers. Nor does the Air Force or any U.S. military agency have a flying saucer.

"I don't like this continued long-range occurrence of what might be called mass hysteria about flying saucers. The Air Force has had teams of experts investigating all reports since the end of the Second World War, and they never have found anything to substantiate existence of such things as flying saucers."
