
Attacked By Flying Saucer

VETERAN PILOT'S CLAIM

Washington, Aug. 1. — The United States Air Force did its best yesterday to knock down "flying saucer" reports, but civilians seemed determined to keep them flying.

A whole new batch of saucer stories turned up in the wake of the air force's explanation that heat waves and optical and radar illusions apparently were causing it all. Some of the reports seemed more fantastic than ever.

The Cleveland press told of a veteran air force pilot who claimed that his fighter plane was "attacked repeatedly by a flying saucer." A former air force pilot in California claimed that he saw a saucer that split in two and kept on going.
