

CHASED SAUCER

New York, Monday. —
Two fighter pilots chased
a "flying saucer" over
Dayton (Ohio).

They reported that "some-
thing" colored red and white
hovered for about 10 seconds
at 17,000ft.

Then it disappeared at
high speed, they said.

The pilots added that they
patrolled the area for a
while afterward, "making
sure it had not been a light
reflection."

The "saucer" was seen
over the Wright-Patterson
Air Force base.

In Tokio flying saucers
were reported over Japanese
territory for the first time
on Friday night.

People in the western
suburbs saw lights moving
in the sky.

One person described the
light as "like a lump of
moon, and travelling very
fast."

Another saw "a bluish light, with a tail sweeping across the sky."

Central Weather Bureau officials said the lights could not have been fireworks or shooting stars.
