

# Saucer was balloon

**SYDNEY, Tues.—Many people thought they saw a flying saucer over Sydney between 10 a.m. and mid-day today, but investigation showed it was a weather balloon.**

First of many reports was that detectives and staff at the C.I.B. building had seen a large white disc float across the sky about mid-day.

Detectives said later the object could have been a

“strip of film” being flown through the air.

Two officers attached to Central District Ambulance also reported seeing the object.

The Weather Bureau said tonight a “met-balloon” had been released by the radio physics laboratory at the University at 9.16 a.m.

The balloon would have travelled over the city as it climbed to 65,000 feet.
