

"Flying Saucer" Was Weather Balloon

SYDNEY: Many people thought they saw a flying saucer over Sydney between 10 a.m. and mid-day yesterday, but investigation showed it was a weather balloon.

First of many reports was that detectives and staff at the C.I.B. building had seen "a large white disc float across the sky" about mid-day.

Two officers attached to Central District Ambulance also reported seeing the object.

The Weather Bureau said last night that a "met-balloon" had been released by the radio physics laboratory at the university at 9.16 a.m. The balloon would have travelled over the city as it climbed to 65,000ft.
