

Three people see 'saucer' over Sydney

Two young women and a man said they saw a flying saucer over Sydney last night.

All three said the saucer travelled over the city in a southerly direction.

The young women are Miss Joan Harrison, 21, shop assistant, of Bligh Street, Epping, and Miss Marlene Johnson, 19, receptionist, of Clarence Road, Rose Bay.

They were standing together on the steps of

Mark Foy's, Liverpool Street.

Miss Harrison said: "It was a long oval thing, sort of flat, and it had a glow about it.

"It made no noise, and passed over Foy's in a southerly direction about 9.50 p.m.

"It wasn't very high —

It was ~~very high~~ —
about as high as the A.W.A.
tower."

Oval shape

Miss Johnson said: "It had an oval shape, and glowed yellow-green with mauve tints.

"We watched it for perhaps five seconds before it disappeared behind buildings.

"A lot of people in the street must have seen it."

The man, Mr. Herbert Barker, accountant, of Holdsworth Avenue, Elizabeth Bay, said he saw the object about 9.25 p.m.

He said: "I was driving my car along Elizabeth Bay Road when I saw this oval shape—a yellow glow with purple edges and a dark centre.

"It seemed about 10ft. across.

"It was travelling south.

"I watched it fly toward the sea and out of sight."
