

"FLYING SAUCER" TRACKED DOWN

NEW YORK, Thursday.

A United States Air Force pilot set off after a "flying saucer" over Chicago — and flew right through it.

But all he saw was "empty air." There was nothing at the spot where radar showed an unexplained object.

A Civil Aeronautics administration official explained that the reflections could be caused by atmospheric conditions, difference between two layers of air, temperature differentials and possibly, differences in electrical charges in patches of air.
