

SOUGHT "SAUCER," SAW "MONSTER"

NEW YORK, Sept. 14.—Seven people reported seeing a glowing "Frankenstein-like monster" while investigating reports that a flying saucer had landed near Sutton (West Virginia).

Gene Lemon (17) was leading the group up the hill when he said he saw what appeared to be a pair of bright eyes in a tree.

When he shone his light on it he saw a 10ft. monster with a "blood red face and a green body that seemed to glow."

Mrs. Kathlyn May, and five others in the group,

said Lemon let out a scream and fell over backwards.

She said the monster, which appeared to be about 4ft. wide, started towards them with a floating, bouncing motion.

"There was an overpowering gaseous smell that burned my nostrils and made me sick," said Mrs. May.

"Several of the party passed out and vomited for

several hours after returning to town."

Police laughed off the report. They said the "monster" had grown from 7ft. to 11ft. in 24 hours.
