

"Saucers" in Navy trials

LONDON, Sat.—A "flying saucer" entered the Atlantic Pact nations' "Mainbrace" fleet manoeuvres yesterday.

The Royal Air Force station at Topcliffe reported to exercise headquarters that a silver object, circular in shape, appeared five miles behind a meteor jet fighter flying at 15,000ft., and maintained a slow forward speed before descending with a pendulum motion.

When the Meteor jet turned back towards base the object appeared to follow suit.

The object then began a rotary motion about its own axis, and suddenly accelerated at incredible speed in a westerly direction, but later turned to a south-easterly course.
