

Flying Saucer Enters Manoeuvres

LONDON, Sun.—A “flying saucer” entered the Mainbrace manoeuvres by Atlantic Pact nations yesterday.

An R.A.F. station reported to exercise headquarters that a silver object, circular in shape, appeared five miles behind a Meteor fighter flying at 15,000 feet.

The object maintained a slow forward speed before descending with a swing pendulum motion.

When the meteor turned

back towards base, the object appeared to follow suit.

The object then began a rotary motion about its own axis they had seen in the air.

It suddenly accelerated at incredible speed in a westerly direction but later turned to a south-easterly course.
