

Flying saucer study

LONDON, Sept. 22.—Royal Air Force experts yesterday studied reports from 10 experienced officers and men who have described with almost identical details the appearance and behaviour of a "flying saucer" over a North of England aerodrome on Saturday.

This is the second time within a week that European observers familiar with aerial objects have announced sighting "saucers."

In Central Sweden last Saturday, ex-air force flyer, Ture Innala, watched a "snowplough-shaped cloud with bubbling smoke from

its tail" appear very high and streak across the sky at a colossal speed.

It dropped a "blue-green shimmering plate which changed course and disappeared equally fast in the opposite direction."
