

FLYING SAUCER REPORTS

LONDON, Monday. Royal Air Force experts are studying the reports from experienced officers and men who have described with almost identical details the appearance and behavior of a "flying saucer" over a North of England aerodrome on Saturday.

This was the second time within a week that European observers familiar with aerial objects have announced sightings of "saucers."

In Central Sweden last Saturday, ex-Air Force officer, Lure Inlala, watched a "snowplough shaped cloud with bubbling smoke from its tail" appear very high and streak across the sky at colossal speed.

It dropped a "blue green shimmering plate, which changed course and disappeared equally fast in the opposite direction."

Another report of a "saucer" came from the West Swedish port of Gothenburg yesterday. Two men reported seeing a noiseless, brightly shining object moving at great speed across the sky at about 6500 feet. They said the object had a phosphorescent tail.
