

## **MORE WORD OF FLYING SAUCERS**

**LONDON, Monday.**

Royal Air Force experts are studying the reports from ten experienced officers and men who have described with almost identical details the appearance and behaviour of a "flying saucer" over a North of England aerodrome on Saturday.

This was the second time within a week that European obser-

vers familiar with aerial objects have announced sighting "saucers."

In central Sweden last Saturday, ex-Air Force flyer, Ture Innala, watched a "snow plough shaped cloud with bubbling smoke from its tail" appear very high and streak across the sky at colossal speed.

It dropped a "blue - green shimmering plate, which chang-

ed course and disappeared equally fast in the opposite direction."

Another report of a "saucer" came from the west Swedish port of Gothenburg yesterday. Two men reported seeing a noiseless, brightly shining object moving at great speed across the sky at about 6,500 feet. They said the object had a phosphorescent tail.
