

WHAT DID THEY SEE?

Reports of Strange Object

That some unidentified object, flying faster than any known aircraft tore over Whyalla last Saturday night has been reported from four separate sources.

Mr. M. Easton, an operator at Ozone Theatre, reports that he was looking out of a window of the projection room at approximately 8.40 p.m. when he saw the object, cigar shaped and glowing red, with a brighter red glow from its tail travel across his line of vision at a faster speed than any aircraft he has even seen. He lost sight of the object when it travelled behind a lattice work protection along the side of the theatre.

A similar report came from Miss Audrey Genner and her sister who were patrons at the theatre.

Mr. Sid Ward, a part time taxi driver, states that he was travelling into Whyalla from the Single Men's Quarters at 8.40 p.m. when a strange object flew over, parallel to the ground. He and his passenger left the taxi and watched the object for a few seconds.

Witnesses report that no noise came from the object. During the week reports appeared in the city press to the effect that a strange object was seen flying over many parts of the State on Saturday night, including Port Pirie, Crystal Brook and Port Wakefield.

Work is progressing on the Lincoln Highway. Five and a half miles have been sealed beyond the aerodrome gate.
