

S.A. Reports Of Sky Object

Eight people yesterday reported having seen a "flying saucer" or similar object in the sky over the suburbs and at Freeling on Saturday night and early yesterday.

Returning to Freeling between 11 p.m. and midnight on Saturday, three men saw a red glowing object in the sky.

The men said the object was "travelling at a terrific speed, was the size of a large dinner plate and appeared to be spinning."

It was visible for several seconds.

Mrs. E. C. Rix, of Edwin terrace, Gilberton, said that she saw a "ball of light" over the St. Peters or Norwood district.

It was electric blue in color and seemed to be travelling very slowly.

A Camden man reported that a pale blue round object flew directly over him from south to north.

The Government Astronomer (Mr. G. F. Dodwell) said that the object appeared to be a large meteor.
