

## FOUR SEE 'FLYING SAUCER' IN WA

**D**ALWALLINU, Fri: Four Dalwallinu residents say they saw what appeared to be a "flying saucer" in the western and south-western sky.

Richard Hunter and Keith McNamara, who were fox-hunting north of Dalwallinu, said that the object appeared to be a large star surrounded by a white, vaporous ring. It travelled west for about half an hour, dimming and brightening alternately, then disappeared over the horizon.

Messrs. L. Angel and K. P. Jefferis said they also saw the object.

Government Astronomer H. S. Spigl said today that, from the report, it would appear the object was travelling too fast to be an astronomical body such as a meteorite.

The Perth Weather Bureau said it certainly wasn't a meteorological balloon.

RAAF, Pearce, and Air Traffic Control, Guildford, said they had no aircraft in the area at the time.
