

FLYING SAUCER STORY

BRISBANE, January 20. — Two brothers, Alan and Arnold Schnitzerling, who returned to Brisbane from a country trip tonight, now believe in all flying saucer stories.

Alan said: "We were driving along a road near the border west of Texas when we noticed a bright light on the horizon and close to it a reddish light not as bright. We drove a few miles further and then we saw it following us about a mile away.

"We were going about 20 miles an hour and it kept pace with us. As we got closer to it it shot up at terrific speed, circled and came back right at us. I got out of the truck to open a gate and when I looked up it had slowed to about 10 miles an hour and was landing about 200 yards away. It was terrifically bright. I took one look and set the Queensland record for shutting a gate.

"We really kicked up some gravel getting away from there. It went about five miles away, swerved and came back beside our truck. It followed us for

our truck. It followed us for about two miles until we turned off to Mingoola station."

The brothers believe that "the thing" was a power-driven object. "The faster it went the brighter the light got," they said. "The light was about 3 ft in diameter."
