

FLYING SAUCERS

They decided to return to Dalwallinu and reported the matter to Mr. Les Angel and Mr. K. P. Jefferis, both of whom also saw the object which by this time was moving in a south-westerly direction. They all four watched it until it disappeared over the south-western horizon.
