

## Will probe "saucers"

Melbourne now has an "Australian Flying Saucer Investigation Committee," to receive and investigate reports in Australia of "flying saucers."

It includes four members of the Astronomical Society of Victoria and a former RAAF pilot.

Similar organisations exist in several oversea countries.

The society's honorary secretary, Mr L. J. Whitney, of Wright Street, Essendon, said today it would give careful and impartial consideration to all reports of "saucers" in Australia.

Significant reports would be referred to experts in physics, aeronautics meteorology and other sciences.

Mr Whitney said people seeing unexplained lights or objects in the sky should send a description with details of time and place to the honorary secretary, Australian Flying Saucer Committee, care GPO Box 5278, Melbourne.
