

## LOW-FLYING SAUCER ?

A second report of the sighting of what appeared to be a "flying saucer" was made yesterday by prominent businessman and sportsman, Mr. Norm. Duce, who said he had seen an object in the sky over Booval on Tuesday afternoon.

This follows a report by Mr. W. Woods, William Street, Woodend, of seeing four silver objects in the sky at 1 p.m. on Saturday.

Mr. Duce said yesterday that he and his wife, with a friend, Mr. R. Munckton, were on the lawn of his residence in Brisbane Road, Booval, shortly after 4 p.m. when they saw a bright object low over the city.

The silver object seemed to be rolling in the same position, and Mr. Duce decided to have a look at it through field glasses, but before he could reach them the "saucer" began to move away in a southerly direction at great speed.

Mr. Duce said it had been low and very plain. It was bright silver in colour, and appeared to have flat sides, while being oval in shape. In size it was no bigger than a small plane, but it did not have wings. When last seen it was moving at a high rate of speed, but there was no noise.
