

GERMANY CLAIMS "FLYING SAUCER"

Germany had developed flying saucers capable of flying at twice the speed of sound before the war ended, a German newspaper claimed.

The newspaper, the Hamburg Welt Am Sonntag, said that one of the flying saucers had fallen into Russian hands.

In a published interview with George Klein, former special deputy in the Nazi War Production Ministry, the newspaper said that the first saucer flight was made in February, 1945.

There had been three separate models, but two had been destroyed as the Russians advanced
