

GERMANY HAD FLYING SAUCER?

BERLIN, April 28.—George Klein, war-time aviation adviser, claimed Germany experimented with the first flying saucer-shaped planes in 1945. He said the first crew-carrying flying saucer was tested at Prague on February 15, 1945. It reached 40,300 feet in three minutes, and flew at 1375 miles per hour. Prototype and plans were destroyed.
